Winter Storage Policy

The Washburn County Fair Association offers winter storage for motorhomes/RV, campers, boats/pontoons, trailers, travel trailers and cars/trucks.

Storage rates will be charged at the (2019) rate of \$10.75 per linear foot (including hitch/tongue, spare, motor, bumper) with a 25 cent increase each year thereafter.

A \$100.00 deposit (checks made payable to the Washburn County Fair Association) is required to secure your spot for the following fall. Space will be awarded on a first come first serve basis. Your deposit must include a description of type and length of unit you are storing. Include a **valid** email address for future communication. The balance must be paid the day the unit(s) is placed in storage.

Storage season is for 6 months running from November 1st- April 31st. All units must be in by November 1st and out by April 31st.

The put in dates for 2019 will be all Wednesday evenings October 2, 9, 16, 23 and 30 from 3 – 6 pm as well as Saturdays October 12th and 26th from 8 am to noon. Please call Pat at the number above to verify when you are coming in so he knows who to expect on each date if possible.

Once your deposit is received you will be notified of the times available to bring in your unit(s).

At time of drop off you must submit the following:

1. Proof of Insurance (Physical Property Damage and Liability) coverage. Insurance information should be available from your agent and can be sent directly to the fair office by your insurance company.
2. Balance of payment due. Make check payable to Washburn County Fair Association.
3. Completed Contract

Additional Information

While items are in winter storage the following rules must be followed.

1. Stored items should not contain removable fuel tanks.
2. Do not plug in stored items.
3. All food items need to be removed from stored items.
4. Disconnect any batteries in stored items.
5. Do not start any motorized items while stored in buildings except for putting in and taking out.
6. No access to property between storage in and removal dates.
7. No padlocks on hitches. Fair personnel may be required to move property as needed.
8. Property not removed by removal date may incur a late removal fee as determined by the Washburn County Fair Association.
