

## Prizes for the "Quilt-Topia" Challenge

## Contest Theme; "How Sweet it is!"

Stitch this to your heart's desire! We encourage creativity, so anything that comes to your mind when you think of this theme can come out in your fabric and seams.

### Contest Details;

- \*Only one square, with backing, batting and bound should be submitted
  - \*Entry must be square
  - \*The finished Square should be no smaller than 12"x12" and no larger than 16"x16"
  - \* The finished square can be quilted or tied.
  - \*The finished square should be pieced, not appliqued
  - \*The finished square should be made with solid fabrics (no prints)
  - \*The finished square can have no more than six different colors
  - \*The finished square can be hand or machine sewn
  - \*The finished square must not have curves in the design
  - \*Entry must be completed by the exhibitor or group of exhibitors
  - \*Entry must be family-friendly
  - \* Only one entry allowed per exhibitor, if exhibitor is a part of a group they cannot compete as an individual as well.

Judging will take place at the **Tri-County Dairy Breakfast** at the Washburn County Fairgrounds on **June 8th, 2019.**

- \*Judging will take place at 9am and by conducted by a panel of judges
